## Key Conclusion – WG III

- Develop Integrated national/regional action plans as they trigger the development of an comprehensive and integrated approach
  - MS should learn from existing examples and adapt them to national conditions
  - Should include plans for food & non food biomass
  - Use small demonstrations to show the different options and possible ways of implementation
  - Guarantee investment security (industry, farmer)
  - Consider different mentalities (e.g. Austria, Greece)
  - Investigate different technology pathways



## Key Conclusion – WG III

- Change the focus of discussion (good/bad bioenergies) towards a more holistic view (e.g. footprint for all production patterns)
- Educate “sustainable citizen”
- Link agriculture to GHG emission trading (conversion of land)
